Autumn Quarterly Meeting

The Autumn Meeting will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 19 in the Atrium (in the former convent) at St. Mary Church, 684 S. Third Street in Columbus. Our speaker will be Society member, Dr. Tony Lisska of Denison University. He will tell us of James Whelan, O.P. (1823-1878), bishop, scientist, theologian, historian, and orator. Whelan, born in Ireland and raised in New York City, was educated and lived and served the Church in Ohio until being named Bishop of Nashville just before the Civil War. Dr. Lisska remarks that the original promise of Whelan's life was not realized "primarily because he was the wrong person in the wrong place at the wrong time." Come and hear this interesting story.
