Spring Quarterly Meeting

Our Spring Quarterly Meeting will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 20 in the Atrium at St. Mary Church, 684 S. Third St., Columbus. Society member and Denison University professor Dr. Tony Lisska will speak on "The Eastern Europeans come to Central Ohio -- East Columbus as a Roman Catholic Company Town." Dr. Lisska has been researching and writing a history of the village of East Columbus, the area along Fifth Avenue east of Cassady Avenue, which had its own corporate identity from 1916 until 1932. This talk will focus on Catholic aspects of the story and the interaction with St. Thomas the Apostle Parish and St. Mary of the Springs.

Also at this meeting we intend to select a patron saint for the society and to have a silent auction of triplicate materials from the society's library and files.

A Popular History of the Diocese

As those who attended the most recent meetings are aware, the diocese has launched a project to have a new, "popular" history published by Éditions du Signe of Strasbourg, France. This company has published many diocesan and religious order histories in recent years. The new, 144-page history is expected to have over 350 photographs, including at least one of each existing parish, and many from the Society's files and from the diocesan archives and others. It should prove to be quite colorful, popular, and reasonably priced. The publisher sells the books primarily through the parishes. Projected delivery date is February, 2001.
