His topic will be: "The Bishop Died Praying: the Life, the Times, and the Death of Bishop Edward G. Hettinger, 1902-1996" We will learn of "the bishop of superlatives: the funniest, longest reigning, most humble and unforgettable of bishops," as recalled by his former altar boy, later the priest who was at his deathbed.

**Our Patron**

Some years ago St. Bede, commonly called "The Venerable," was elected the patron of our society (over St. Luke and St. Colmille). Although he never left his native Northumbria, where he was born in the year 673, this Benedictine priest was considered the most learned man of his day. He wrote on many subjects, including history, rhetoric, cosmography, astronomy, music, grammar, philosophy, and exegesis. The best known of his works on history is the thorough "Ecclesiastical History of the English People." He went to his reward in 735 and his feast day is on May 25. Ask his intercession for us!
