



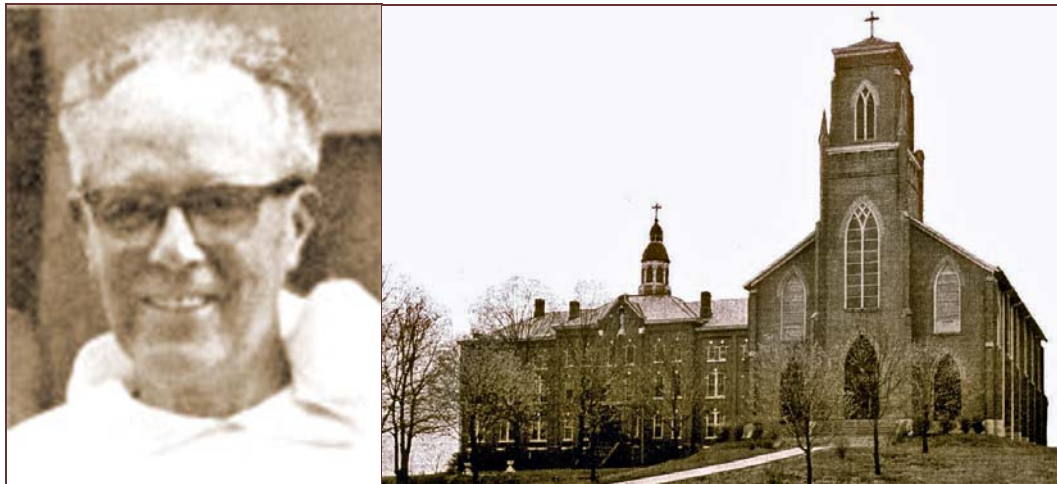

The Spring Quarterly Meeting will be held at Our Lady of Victory parish center, on Roxbury Road, Marble Cliff, beginning at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 16

Dr. Tony Lisska will present the results of his recent investigation of the life of Dominican Father James Bernard Walker.

Tony describes his talk as “A Somerset Lad who became a Dominican Prior, an Archivist, and a Postulator for a Canonization: John Bernard Walker, O.P.”

Father Walker was one of the twelve children of Charles and Maggie (Flautt) Walker of Somerset, born in 1896. He served in the World War, then entered the Dominican Order and was ordained in 1929. After a long and fruitful career, he departed this life in 1984. Tony promises an “unsanitized” biography.
